## Exodus 20:1-4, 7-9, 12-20 Common English Bible

Then God spoke all these words: <sup>2</sup>I am the LORD your God who brought you out of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. <sup>3</sup>You must have no other gods before me. <sup>4</sup>Do not make an idol for yourself—no form whatsoever—of anything in the sky above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth.

<sup>7</sup>Do not use the LORD your God's name as if it were of no significance; the LORD won't forgive anyone who uses his name that way. <sup>8</sup>Remember the Sabbath day and treat it as holy. <sup>9</sup>Six days you may work and do all your tasks...

<sup>12</sup>Honor your father and your mother so that your life will be long on the fertile land that the LORD your God is giving you. <sup>13</sup>Do not kill. <sup>14</sup>Do not commit adultery. <sup>15</sup>Do not steal. <sup>16</sup>Do not testify falsely against your neighbor. <sup>17</sup>Do not desire and try to take your neighbor's house. Do not desire and try to take your neighbor's wife, male or female servant, ox, donkey, or anything else that belongs to your neighbor. <sup>18</sup>When all the people witnessed the thunder and lightning, the sound of the horn, and the mountain smoking, the people shook with fear and stood at a distance. <sup>19</sup>They said to Moses, "You speak to us, and we'll listen. But don't let God speak to us, or we'll die."
