## Luke 24:13-16, 28-33 Common English Bible

<sup>13</sup> On that same day, two disciples were traveling to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> They were talking to each other about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup> While they were discussing these things, Jesus himself arrived and joined them on their journey. <sup>16</sup> They were prevented from recognizing him.

<sup>28</sup> When they came to Emmaus, he acted as if he was going on ahead. <sup>29</sup> But they urged him, saying, "Stay with us. It's nearly evening, and the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them. <sup>30</sup> After he took his seat at the table with them, he took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. <sup>31</sup> Their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he disappeared from their sight. <sup>32</sup> They said to each other, "Weren't our hearts on fire when he spoke to us along the road and when he explained the scriptures for us?" <sup>33</sup> They got up right then and returned to Jerusalem. They found the eleven and their companions gathered together.
